

MATERIALS

YARN

Anthology Meadow: 100% merino/corriedale wool, 200 yards (182m) • 50g (1.76oz)

MC (Dropseed): 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9, 10, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 skeins

CC (Trout Lily): all sizes - 1 skein

NEEDLE(S)

US 4 (3.5 mm) 16"/40 cm – 40"/100 cm circular (depending on size);
DPNs in same size for sleeves if not using magic loop – or size needed to obtain gauge

NOTIONS

Stitch markers (3 total for the A-Line option or 1 for the straight version);
two stitch holders or pieces of scrap yarn for the sleeves and a tapestry needle

GAUGE

In stockinette st: 24 sts and 30 rounds per 4"/10 cm

In chart pattern: 24 sts and 30 rounds per 4"/10 cm

On occasion the knitter will knit stranded colorwork with a tighter gauge.
It may be necessary to go up a needle size when knitting the chart.
